

## ASP2022 VACCINATION POLICY AND COVID-19 PROTOCOLS\*\*

ASP IS REQUIRING PROOF OF A COVID-19 VACCINATION FROM ALL ATTENDEES,

SPEAKERS AND GUESTS

ASP will accept proof of the following types of vaccinaitons listed below:

 AstraZeneca/Oxford, Johnson & Johnson, Pfizer/BioNTech, Moderna, Sinopharm, Sinovac and Covishield

You are considered fully vaccinated against COVID-19 at least 14 days after your second dose of the Pfizer-BioNtech or Moderna COVID-19 vaccine (or other COVID-19 vaccinations recognized by the WHO or at least 14 days after your single dose of the Johnson & Johnson's COVID-19 vaccine).

\*\*Vaccination card image will be required to upload in the registration form.

ASP will also require a rapid antigen or PCR test (to be taken no more than 2 days prior to arrival). This can be submitted by form, emailed to aspannualmeeting@gmail.com or presented at registration on the day of your arrival.



Masks are required in all

conference

spaces, except when actively eating or drinking. ASP will provide reusable masks to attendees at check-in.

Except in cases where exemptions based on medical or religious grounds are determined to be appropriate by ASP's Executive Committee. In cases of granted exemptions, proof of a negative COVID-19 test will be required prior to and during the conference week. If a child will be accompanying you to the conference as a guest and is under the age of 5, proof of a negative COVID-19 test will be required in lieu of a vaccination record.
