

ASP2023 Health & Safety Policies *

Participants acknowledge that COVID-19 is an infectious virus that spreads easily through person-to-person contact and may cause serious illness to individuals who are unvaccinated and/or have certain medical risk factors. Federal and state public health authorities have issued basic health and safety guidelines aimed at mitigating the spread of the virus. Participants understand attending ASP2023 may increase the risk of contracting COVID-19. ASP in no way warrants that the protective measures prescribed for ASP2023 conference will completely prevent exposure to the COVID-19 virus. Participants agree to follow all public health and safety guidelines to attend ASP2023 and acknowledge the risk of potential COVID-19 exposure and infection during the meeting.
